

DeTECToR Workshop: Save the date

The CEDR project DeTECToR (Decision-support Tools for Embedding Climate change Thinking on Roads) will develop tools and guidance specifically designed to help road operators integrate climate change issues in two key areas - economic appraisal and procurement processes.

Please save the date for the DeTECToR workshop which will be held on 4th April 2017 at the Diamant Conference & Business Centre, Brussels, Belgium.

Who Should Attend: Personnel from national road administrations working in areas such as asset management, procurement, economic appraisal, environmental impact assessment and asset information. Researchers and experts outside of road administration organisations are also welcome to attend.

About the Workshop: The DeTECToR team will present the initial results of the project and outline our plans to use this information to develop practical tools and guidance for road operators. Participants will hear about the experiences of other road operators from across Europe and discuss the types of information and guidance needed to make informed decisions on climate change and embed this in operations and procurement processes. This is an opportunity to shape the tools and guidance produced by the project, so that they provide the right information in the format which is most suitable for your needs.

About the Project: Climate change presents a significant challenge for road operators, both in dealing with its impacts on their network, and in finding ways to reduce their greenhouse gas contributions. This two year project was commissioned by CEDR to help road administrations put into practice the latest research and good practice relating to climate change. It will produce two sets of decision-support tools and guidance documents, the first set to help road operators integrate climate change risks into economic appraisal and the second for embedding climate change mitigation and adaptation in operations and procurement processes. *More information on the DeTECToR project can be found on the project website at <http://detector.trl.co.uk/>*
